- e. be worshippers with obedience to the leading of the Holy Spirit.

The Training will also cover:

- 1. Team building Relationship development, Conflict resolution, Forgiveness, Respect for one another (sharing stories, maintaining unity, discovering & using gifts and ministries, humility to learn from each other)
- 2. Relationship with God Prayer, Holy Spirit, Love, Servant-hood, Purity, Attitudes, Unity, Dependence on God

- 4. Practical guidelines for going on missions

The training will be specifically geared for Young adults (approximately 17 to 35 years of age, although older will be considered). The training is hands-on and practical, and participants will be given ample opportunity to put their new skills into practice.
