All: We give thanks and praise for all that God has done for us

All: Let us give Him thanks and praise

Celebrant: God sent the Holy spirit to gather us together as the people of God.

Celebrant: So come, let us join together to worship this God who loves us

All: Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, Heaven and earth are full of your glory.

Celebrant: Accept our praises, heavenly Father, through your son our Saviour Jesus Christ; and as we follow his example and obey his command, grant that by the power of your Holy spirit these gifts of bread and wine may be to us his body and his blood

Celebrant: We praise you that before he suffered and died, our saviour gave us this holy meal to Share and told us to continue it until he comes again.

All: Why do we eat bread together at this table?

Celebrant: On the night before he died, Jesus took bread. After giving thanks, he broke it and gave it It to his disciples saying: "Take, eat.....this is my body this in remembrance of me."

All: Why do we drink from the cup together at this table?

Celebrant: in the same way, after supper, Jesus took the cup saying: "This cup is God's new covenant sealed with my blood....poured out for the you for the forgiveness of sins. Do this in remembrance of me."

All: What do we remember at this table?

Celebrant: We remember the Father's gracious love for us, Christ's death and resurrection for us and the spirits tender care for us. So let us proclaim the mystery of faith

All: Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again.

Celebrant: In memory of his death and resurrection, we offer you, Father, this life-giving bread, this saving cup.

We thank you for counting us worthy to stand in your presence and serve you. May all of us who share in the body and blood of Christ be brought together in unity by the Holy spirit.

Lord, remember your church throughout the world; make us grow in love, together with *N* our bishop, and all the departed into the light of your presence.

Have mercy on us all; make us worthy to share eternal life with Mary, the virgin mother of God, with the apostles, and with all the saints who have done your will throughout the ages.

May we praise you in union with them, and give you glory through your Son, Jesus Christ.

Through him, with him, in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all the glory and honour is yours, almighty Father, for ever and ever. **Amen**
